United Nations **General Assembly**

The General Assembly, with its roughly 193 members from the United Nations, is like the heart of the UN – serving as the deliberative, policy making, and representative core of the UN. It's basically a mini version of the real UNGA, giving delegates a chance to talk about important discussions and decision-making processes just like world leaders do. So, if you're heading to HFS MUN 2024 and jumping into the General Assembly, you're basically joining in on this global brainstorming session where we all work together to tackle the world's toughest problems.

The Security Council, with its double delegations, is perhaps the most prolific committee at HFS MUN. The P5 nations and all the other countries in the UNSC make up a crew like the SWAT team of the UN – they're responsible for maintaining international peace and security, and they don't mess around. Just like in the real UNSC, delegates at HFS MUN 2024 get to step up as representatives of these powerful nations and hash out all kinds of issues. League of Nations

Details

- Participation in HFS MUN 2024 is open to students ranging from 8th to 12th grade.
- For a school to be recognised as a delegation at the event, a minimum of **5** delegates is required.
- The Secretariat of HFS MUN 2024 allows participating schools to exercise discretion in allocating their delegation among various committees and countries. However, it is strongly encouraged that schools carefully consider their delegate selection process, taking into account students' proficiency in debating and their enthusiasm for global politics and international relations. A well-rounded delegation ensures that all participants have an enriching and educational conference experience.
- The registration fee for HFS MUN 2024 is set at ₹4699 per delegate as part of the early bird discount valid till June 30, 2024. This fee covers delegate kits and 3 meals (breakfast, lunch, and high tea) for the 3 days at Meluha The Fern Hotel. Additionally, registered participants will receive a timetable detailing each day's events. Payment should be made at the time of registration via the provided payment link.
